Presbyterians Sharing supports Dr. Nicholas (Nick) and Rebecca (Becky) Bauman as they serve a two-year appointment with the United Mission to Nepal.

Nick serves as a General Surgeon at the United Mission Hospital Tansen (UMHT) which was first established in 1954. His responsibilities include providing surgical services and teaching post-graduate residents in the Medical Doctorate in General Practice. In 2015/16, the hospital met the needs of over 98,000 people in Western Nepal and nearby North India.

Becky is an Occupational Therapist who believes that mission is all about relationship. When not spending time with her three young children, she is looking to build relationships with the people around her and helping where there is a need.

Mission has always played an important role in the Baumans' lives. Nick shares, "My faith community has always stressed the importance of mission, particularly the sense that our lives are not our own, but are gifts, and that we are entrusted by God to be stewards of this gift."
