In the midst of the conflict caused by the ongoing Israeli military occupation of Palestinian territory, The Presbyterian Church in Canada (International Ministries) supports a ministry of presence by providing volunteers as human rights monitors to witness and report observations of the difficulties of life under occupation. Through the sponsorship of the World Council of Churches, international volunteers spend three months participating in the Ecumenical Accompaniment Program in Palestine and Israel (EAPPI). These EAs (ecumenical accompaniers) observe and report on situations of conflict and suffering in the occupied territories and return home to heighten awareness of the conflict and promote change. WCC-EAPPI programme coordinator, Zoughbi Zoughbi, refers to the EA volunteers as "renewable sources of hope, standing with people who are suffering, as tangible indications that they are not left alone. The Rev. Diane Tait-Katerberg and the Rev. Gordon Timbers were recent Canadian Presbyterian participants in this ongoing international and ecumenical ministry.
