Presbyterians Sharing supports the Rev. Joel Sherbino as he serves a two-year appointment as part-time Malawi Liaison with the Church of Central Africa Presbyterian (CCAP) in Blantyre Synod.

Joel, minister of Paris Presbyterian Church in Paris, Ontario, has a long history with Blantyre Synod. Accompanied by his wife Rebecca, he served as the Associate Pastor of St. Columba CCAP Church from 2004-2007. He returned to Malawi with his family from 2015-2016, serving as the Associate Pastor of Ndirande Kachere CCAP Church. Joel also worked as an Associate Prison Chaplain for Blantyre Synod's prison ministry, visiting prisons in Southern Malawi where he led Bible studies and provided mentorship to inmates.

As a part-time Malawi Liaison, Joel will continue the longstanding partnership with the CCAP in Blantyre Synod and offer opportunities for Canadian Presbyterians to engage in Christ's mission in Malawi. While continuing his ministry with Paris Presbyterian Church, he will visit Malawi two weeks per year, visiting churches and prisons and connecting with PCC partners. In Canada, he will spend two weeks per year visiting Presbyterian groups and congregations, sharing with them how God is touching lives in Malawi.

Joel shares, "I am excited by what is happening and I look forward to some new possibilities. Thank you again for letting me be part of this ministry."
