– Living Faith, 7.7.4



Miles away, or close at hand, someone waits and waits and waits in nervous anticipation Will they chose me to be their minister?


They have studied, they have tolled in response to God's personal call but that is not enough to be a minister. In the Presbyterian Church in Canada there is no individual quest.

It is true. We are often closer to God in times of adversity rather than tranquility.


