The Cameron Doctoral Bursary fund provides grants to ministers, diaconal ministers and candidates for ministry within The Presbyterian Church in Canada engaged in academic doctoral studies (Ph.D., Th.D. or Ed.D. degrees). Awards will normally be made starting in the second year of the program and are based on the financial needs of the candidates. #### **Grant Programs**
