Below are some questions that synods and presbyteries might consider answering in a project report.

Who does the project serve/equip?

Describe the accomplishments and challenges of the project.

How is the project addressing the challenges in its midst?

What impact is the project having? Where have there been successes?

Share a story of a person or group of people whose life/lives has/have been changed by the project.

What is something new that the project has done this year?

Share how you have seen God at work.

How has God been at work in your project? What biblical verse represent the project, and why? What is the vision for the future?

What aspects of the synod/presbytery could congregations pray for?

Is there anything else that the synod/presbytery would like to share?
