## Worship is at the heart of Christian community.

Worship that is welcoming for children and youth is vital. Here are some suggestions for how to do this:

- Provide a children's bulletin and crayons;
- Prepare and provide worship bags for preschoolers containing soft toys that reflect the liturgy;
- Provide name tags for everyone including children;
- Provide offering envelopes for children and youth;
- Encourage parents to make sure that their child's view is not obstructed – small children should sit toward the front, on a lap, or booster chair;
- Ensure that worship is interactive so that the children are engaged and not expected to just sit still and just listen;
- Be open to trying new ways of worship using biblical translations that are child friendly, different music styles, visual arts, drama and dance.

## How can your church welcome children and youth?



- Plan programs, music and prayers that related to their age and interests.
- Show as many ways as you can that you really want young people present.
- Encourage youth to question and express their opinions and explore their faith.
- Share our faith stories and experiences.
- Be intentional about knowing their names and interests.
- Be a role model. Be respectful, loving and compassionate.
- Invite youth to serve alongside you in all sorts of ways: collecting and counting offering, setting up chairs, cleaning up after events, greeting, working in a food bank, leading prayers, reading Scripture, serving Communion.
- Be an extra adult for a child/youth event a games night, retreat, or sports outing
- Make food for church gatherings that appeals to youth.
- Be ready for children even if they don't show up.
- Create a small play area at the back of your worship space.
- Ensure that your community is a safe and comfortable place to be.
- Show that your faith brings you joy and hope. Smile. Laugh.
