# Rainbow Communion

## We are ...

The Special LGBTQI Listening Committee known as **Rainbow Communion**.

Seven members drawn from across the church reflecting the diversity of the denomination and includes two members who identify as LGBTQI.

#### **OUR MANDATE**

To offer a safe and respectful environment in which confidentiality is assured, in order to encourage people

- to tell stories of harm done to them within and by the church because of homophobia, heterosexism and transphobia; and
- > to share stories of God's grace experienced by them and through them in Christian ministry, even in the midst of the challenges they have faced.

To invite people to submit their stories orally or in writing (face-to-face, video conference, phone call, email, traditional mail, or other means). Stories of those who have given permission to share them may be included in the committee's report to a future General Assembly.

To provide, after the listening process is completed, an appropriate response to the issue of homophobia within The Presbyterian Church in Canada with recommendations for concrete actions addressing homophobia to the General Assembly for implementation within the church.

Trained Rainbow Communion listeners from across Canada (some fluent in additional languages) will be deputized and added to the roster of the listeners. These names will be made available on the website.

## We are not ...

- > a counselling team and the listening space is not a counselling session.
- a committee that directly shapes doctrine, policy or programs of The Presbyterian Church in Canada nor is equipped to handle legal matters.

#### THE LISTENING PROCESS

Two listeners will meet with the person who is interested in sharing their experiences. Listeners will include at least one person from the Rainbow Communion Listening Committee and the second listener may be one who has been trained and deputized by Rainbow Communion. In all cases the selection of the listeners is to be approved by you the storyteller.

This sharing will normally occur face to face and could happen by video conference, on the phone, in written form by letter or email, or by another method acceptable to all at a location approved by the storyteller.

We would encourage you to be prepared to share your story within 60 minutes. If you feel that more time is required, please let us know.

During the listening process, a notetaker will be present (if audio recording is declined) as the story is shared. For those individuals who do not desire that the experiences they disclose be shared, the taking of notes will still occur so that key themes can be identified for purposes of the overall report. In such instances, there will be an opportunity to verify and approve the content (themes discussed, without names or descriptions of events) that may be included for the purposes of the report.

After receiving the account of your experiences, a member of the committee will be in touch and follow up with you. Your story will be kept in the way you indicated on the initial contact information form unless Rainbow Communion is otherwise instructed by you.

With your permission, these accounts will be compiled and form the basis of a report to the General Assembly of The Presbyterian Church in Canada on homophobia and experiences of God's grace in ministry.

Rainbow Communion will be collecting the stories and accounts of experiences from May 15, 2018 to June 15, 2019.

#### YOUR RIGHTS AS THE STORYTELLER

**Confidentiality.** Under normal circumstances only you have the right to tell your own story and share your experiences. What you share is treated as confidential and will not be shared with any office or individual outside of our Rainbow Communion Listening Committee unless you have consented to share your story more broadly with, or without, your name attached.

Individuals in couple or family relationships are responsible for their own handling of confidences shared in their circles or groups.

If there is reason to believe that the person telling the story may do harm to themselves or another person or if there is reason to believe that a minor, is, or may be in danger of neglect or abuse, the team members may share specific and relevant information with appropriate organizations without your consent.

**Privacy.** You have a right to expect as much visual and auditory privacy as may be reasonably provided given the location and the facility where the meeting will take place. If you have concerns about privacy, please share this with the team members in advance, if possible.

The Story-Teller Records. All listening-related material is kept and held confidentially and securely by the Rainbow Communion Listening Committee. The record of the account of your experiences is a part of that material and will be held in the way you confirmed on your permission form. The records will be securely and confidentially maintained following the completion of the listening space. You will be given the opportunity to approve the content that may be used for the purposes of the Committee's report.

**Informed Consent.** You have a right to be meaningfully informed about the listening process. Together you and the listeners who will attend the Listening Space will discuss the details of the informed consent. You are encouraged to ask the listeners for clarification as needed. You also will be asked to give your permission for audio recording to occur in the Listening Space.

**The Listening Approach.** Listening to the story of your experiences is the main purpose of our time together. While listening to your story, the listeners might ask for some information for clarification. You are free to answer or not. You may end the Listening Space at any time if you do not feel comfortable for any reason. If possible, it would be best if you could discuss your decision to end the Listening Space in order for the listeners to understand your concerns.

**Risks of The Listening Approach.** The process of telling our stories and sharing experiences has an impact on us as well as those with whom we are in relationship. Sometimes if the harm done is deep, telling the story might trigger the emotional pain associated with the memories of the experience. The emotional pain may vary from feelings of discomfort to being retraumatized. Please consider bringing someone with you to support you emotionally and/or spiritually and with whom you can debrief afterwards.

## Rainbow

as a symbol of God's promise, has its origin in the biblical covenant with Noah and his family. It is also a term or symbol often used to represent the inclusion of the full diversity of people and emphasizing the inclusion of persons who identify as sexual and/or gender minorities.

### Communion

is central to our life as Christians and in a broader sense reflects the sharing or exchanging of intimate thoughts and feelings, especially when the exchange is on a mental or spiritual level.

LGBTQI is an acronym used to refer to people whose sexual orientation is not heterosexual and/or whose gender identity does not conform either to binary male/female categories or the "assigned" gender at birth. LGBTQI is an acronym for Lesbian, Gay, Bisexual, Transgender, Queer or Questioning, Intersex.
