Dear Prime Minister and Minister,

I write to you on behalf of The Presbyterian Church in Canada, whose 2019 General Assembly met in Waterloo, Ontario.

The General Assembly considered a report regarding Canada's Official Development Assistance. The Presbyterian Church in Canada supports humanitarian assistance programs and overseas partners' development programs through Presbyterian World Service & Development (PWS&D).

The church supports the internationally recognized goal of setting state aid levels to 0.7% of its Gross National Income. We commend Canada's programs and contributions in support of global development, but with current Canadian aid levels at 0.28%, we are far short of this goal. Regrettably, Canadian aid levels have reached a 50-year low. We can do better.

We are concerned, also, that with the passage of Bill C-86 in December 2018, the reporting requirements under the Official Development Assistance Accountability Act have been weakened. We urge the government to publish a breakdown of the Government's annual contribution to the World Bank's aid budget. Indeed, according to a public opinion survey commissioned by the Canadian Council for International Development, a majority of Canadians want Canada to do more to help the world's poorest and most vulnerable people. Reaching 0.7% is an achievable goal – the United Kingdom legislated that British aid levels meet 0.7% of its GNI and has consistently met this goal.

The General Assembly also urges the Government to increase its official development assistance to 0.35% (GNI) in 2020 and develop a plan to increase Canadian ODA to 0.7% of its GNI as part of Canada's implementation framework for the 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development. The

I look forward to hearing from you about this important issue. Please rest assured of our continuing prayers even and especially amidst the challenges posed by the COVID-19 pandemic.
