I am writing on behalf of the 2019 General Assembly of The Presbyterian Church in Canada, which met June 2-6, 2019 in Waterloo, Ontario.

One of the tasks of the General Assembly is to consider international issues of importance to the church. The General Assembly received a report with an update on Canada's involvement in United Nations peacekeeping efforts in Mali.

Canada's decision to re-engage in peacekeeping is significant. The risks associated with deploying peacekeepers in Mali, in particular, are great. However, the danger and uncertainty felt by the people of Mali in this time of conflict warrants the attention and collaborative peacekeeping efforts of the international community. We are grateful that Canada extended its involvement to help facilitate the transition of its responsibilities to Romanian peacekeepers.

We pray for the safety of the people of Mali and all the peacekeepers who are serving there. We also pray for the wisdom of leaders to establish a peaceful and just resolution of the conflict.
