Young Adult Representatives are members of The Presbyterian Church in Canada between the ages of 16 and 25 years. Students at our theological colleges are not eligible nor are professional church workers (ordained, designated or lay).

Meals: Meal expenses, like commissioners, are covered by the presbytery. An invoice will be sent to the presbytery following the General Assembly.

Travel/Accommodation: Travel and accommodation for the YAR are covered by the General Assembly.

2022 General Assembly – Sunday, June 5, 2022

Registration for General Assembly

You will receive the attendance registration material for the General Assembly directly from the General Assembly Office once your presbytery clerk has notified this office. This material will contain a registration form and a letter containing information such as travel, accommodation and costs. There will also be a biographical information form for you to complete.

YAR Orientation

You are to arrive by dinner time on Saturday, June 4. Information about travel arrangements will be in your registration material that will be sent once your presbytery has notified the General Assembly Office.

YAR Mentors

Each year there are mentors for the YARs. They will connect with you before and during the Assembly to offer you support and provide information about the Assembly. They will also arrange the orientation and other connections at the Assembly.

Costs to attend the General Assembly

Your travel and accommodation costs will be covered by the General Assembly Office.

Your meals at the Assembly will be covered by your presbytery.
