	The report indicates in its third last paragraph that "there appeared to be a lack of support for Pathway C" and goes on to imply that a reasoned decision of the Assembly was made on the concept. This comment is incorrect. At the time of discussion on the floor of General Assembly, the Assembly was in a Committee of the Whole wherein only "positive" words about one Pathway could be discussedthis did not and does not represent a valid debate of any of the Pathways (and certainly not on the wider concept of alternate governing bodies). And further, once out of the Committee of the Whole, an immediate vote was called for and allowed, again with no discussion. Therefore The Presbyterian Church in Canada has never had a reasoned, substantive debate as to the merits or demerits of Alternative Governing Bodies.
	The matter deserves a considered discussion within the denomination. This report does not adequately answer the question as to why Alternative Governing Bodies cannot be a workable solution for The Presbyterian Church in Canada.
