The Assembly Council Executive met by video conference on Monday, September 11, 2023. C. Inksetter, convener, opened the meeting with a prayer by Thomas Merton.

### LAND

## ACKNOWLEDGMENT

1/23E

The convener acknowledged the traditional lands of Indigenous people and the church's role in colonization. The church's commitment to healing and reconciliation was expressed.

## 300 BLOOR STREET

MOVE

An update on the move to 300 Bloor Street was provided by V. Kim.

4/23E

Over the summer, the staff committee met with the architects for the planning of the 3,500 feet of space for our denomination. The leasing documents are expected to be signed soon.

At 50 Wynford Drive, staff are preparing for the move. Initial steps include: downsizing equipment/furnishings and implementing the management of files/information (digitally), all to ensure an efficient transition to the new location.

### MANAGEMENT

TEAM

5/23E

I. Ross-McDonald reported for the Management Team. Work at the office during summer focused on coordination of addressing the General Assembly decisions, staff's flexibility as they assist with various staffing transitions, and maintaining regular activities.

# **Interim CFO/Treasurer** 6/23E

J. Waddell shared aspects of his work and the Finance Department, noting that the focus is on maintaining and creating the right technology and responsibilities in order to be efficient and effective.

There have been staff transitions, along with revisions of responsibilities for staff in the Finance Department. Jason Leung is acting in the role of the controller and there is a search for a new Senior Administrator.

J. Waddell reviewed procedures within the department and new ones are being implemented.

# INTERCULTURAL LIAISON

7/23E

The Assembly Council is responsible for the search for the Intercultural Liaison. The call for nominations was sent to presbyteries, colleges and other denominations. The deadline for nominations is January 15, 2024.

The Executive proposed that the search committee be comprised of about 6–7 members, representing the church at large (some from the special committee) and two representatives, each appointed by the Assembly Council and the Life and Mission Agency.

C. Inksetter, V. Kim and I. Ross-McDonald will prepare a list of suggested members for the Executive to consider in order to present a recommendation for the November Council meeting.

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MENTORING FUND FOR NON-EURO CANADIAN CLERGY 8/23E The group preparing the terms of reference for the Mentoring Fund for Non-Euro Canadian Clergy will have a proposal for the Council in November.

REAL ESTATE CONSULTATION

**GROUP** 9/23E

The Real Estate Consultation group has not met. A staff group at the national office is discussing possible uses of property within the denomination. Ideas coming from this group can be shared with the consultation group.

PROPHETIC ROLE OF COUNCIL

10/23E

A summary of the "Narratives of Hope and Possibility" conversations that were held at the General Assembly was circulated. The Executive wants to ensure that the Council, in its prophetic role, continues to seriously look at the narratives for our church.

The November meeting will include time to continue this conversation. In the meantime, V. Kim, along with C. Inksetter, will consult with some people about what next steps are required in proceeding with this conversation.
