the mission and ministry of The Presbyterian Church in Canada

Our gifts to Presbyterians Sharing provide the foundation for what we do together as a denomination. When we give to Presbyterians Sharing, we participate in God's mission by proclaiming love, hope and grace through the words we use, the decisions we make and the actions we take.

The General Assembly, comprised of 200 commissioners from congregations across Canada, inspired by the Spirit, determines the budget and direction for how we will continue Christ's ministry in the world. Gifts gathered in congregations across Canada are sent in faith that God will use them to transform lives. 245 people share time and talent throughout the year by serving on more than 30 committees,

subcommittees and working groups. These groups work together to discern what God is calling us to do, develop educational resources, share experiences, lead conferences and webinars, coach and mentor peers, write letters to governments, reflect theologically and participate in ministry programs. Together we provide funding for ministries, help congregations navigate challenging times, equip leaders to serve the church around the world, speak for those who have been silenced and marginalized, fight racism and discrimination, provide spaces for Indigenous and non-Indigenous people to walk together on a journey of healing and reconciliation and build a church where all are welcome.

The ministry we support nationally builds upon ministry done locally and regionally by congregations, presbyteries and synods. Together we are stewards of gifts from God, and through the power of God, we are accomplishing far more than we can ever imagine.


