- 1. Select setup_eduroam from available networks. You will be directed to cat.eduroam.org.
- Select the blue Click here to download your eduroam® installer button
- Search for and select Wilfrid Laurier University as your institution.
- Select the blue Download your eduroam® installer MS Windows 10 button.
- Open the downloaded installer package to proceed with the installation process.
- Enter your full username and password.
- 7. Navigate to your list of available networks, select eduroam.

MacOS X

- 1. Select setup_eduroam from your list of networks. You will be redirected to cat.eduroam.org.
- Select Click here to download your eduroamo 2.
- Search for and select Wilfrid Laurier University 3.
- 4. Select Continue when you see the "Are you sure you want to install 'eduroamo'?"
- 5, Enter your username and password.
- When prompted, enter your computer password, and select OK. 6.
- Select eduroam from your list of available networks.

MacOS Big Sur

- Select setup_eduroam from your list of networks (close the pop-up) 1.
- Go to cat.eduroam.org -> select the Click here to download your eduroam® installer button. 2.
- 3. Search for and select Wilfrid Laurier University.
- 4. Install the Profile
- Go to your system preferences:
 - Select the Apple menu.
 - Select System Preferences.
- 6. Enter your full username and password
- 7. When prompted, enter your computer username and password.
- In your System Preferences, select Network. -> Select Wi-Fi. 8.
- Make sure setup_eduroam appears in the Network Name field.
- 10. Uncheck Automatically Join this network.
- 11. Select eduroam from the Network Name field.

Chromebooks

- Open the Select a network menu -> choose eduroam.
- In the Wi-Fi network, enter the following settings:
 - EAP method: PEAP
 - Phase 2 authentication: MSCHAPv2
 - Server CA certificate: Default
 - User certificate: None Installed

- Select Profiles. Select eduroamo,

- Identity: Laurier username
- f. Password: Laurier password
- Anonymous identity: leave blank

IOS

- Go to Settings -> Wi-Fi. 1.
- Select eduroam from the list of networks. 2.
- Enter your username and password, -> select join
- You will be prompted to trust the eduroam certificate, Select Trust to connect to eduroam.

Androld

- Open up your list of available Wi-Fi networks. 1.
- 2. Select eduroam.
- Enter the following settings:
 - EAP Method: PEAP a.
 - Identity: Laurier username

- Password: Laurier password
- CA certificate: Don't validate

Google Pixel

- Open up Google PlayStore and search for 'GetEduroam' and install it 1.
- Once it is finished installing, select Open and search for 'Wilfrid Laurier University ' in "select an institution' field then select Next
- Put in your username with @wlu.ca (instead of eva.eduroam.ca) end and select Connect to Network

Troubleshooting

- If the installer prompts for a @wlu.ca email enter your username and replace eva.eduroam.ca with @wlu.ca
- Make sure that the setup eduroam network is not set to a default network
- IOS: if eduroam is not connecting, check that there is only one 'Profile' downloaded on the device
