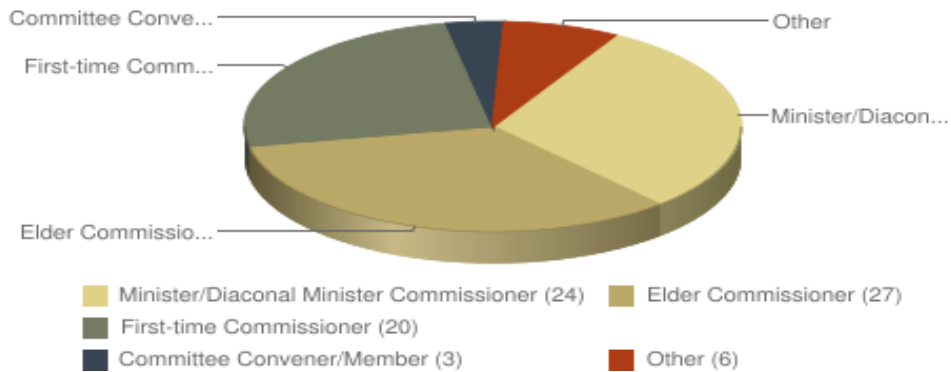
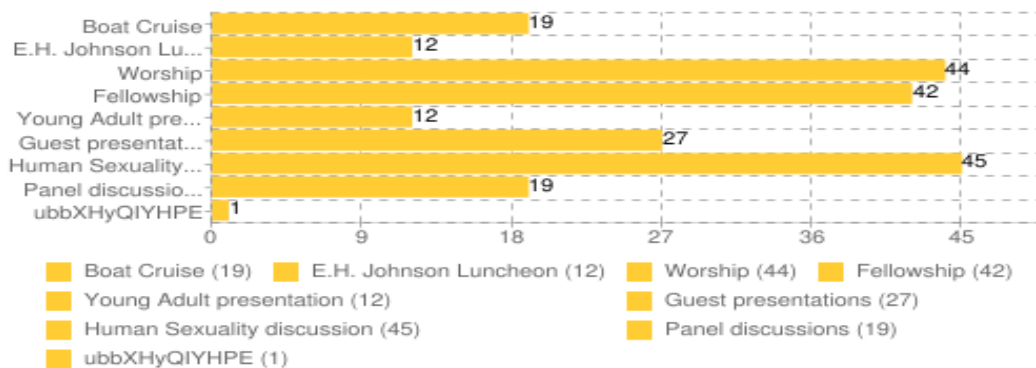

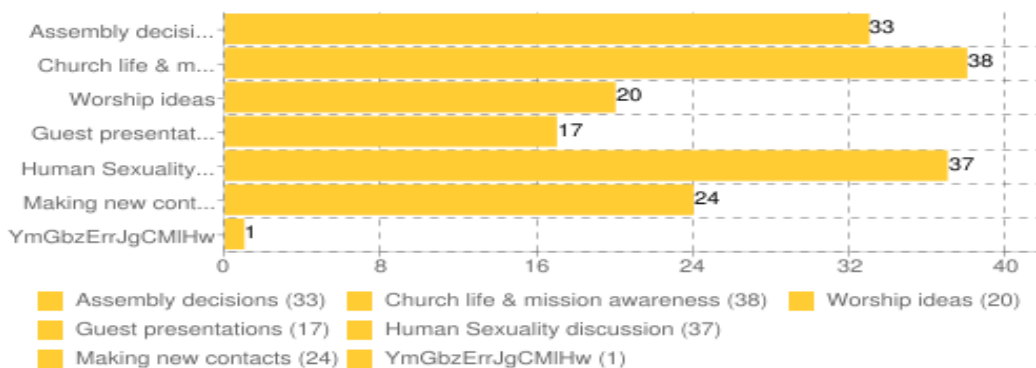
**Number of Survey Respondents in Each Group**



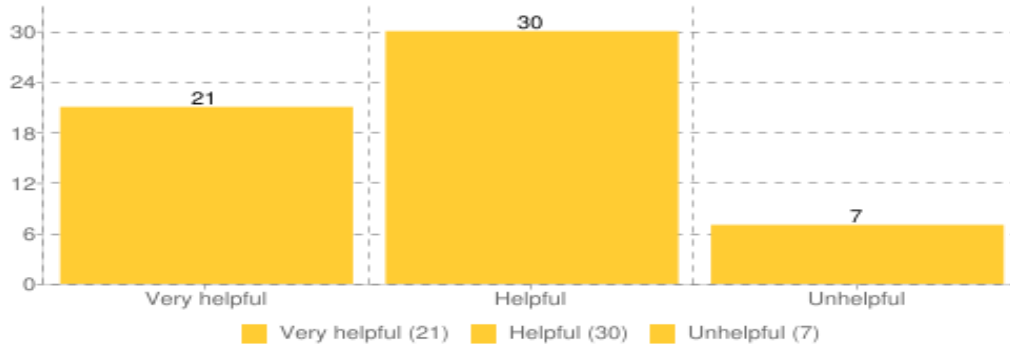
**1. Besides the sederunts, in your opinion, what were some of the most important events to take place during the Assembly?**



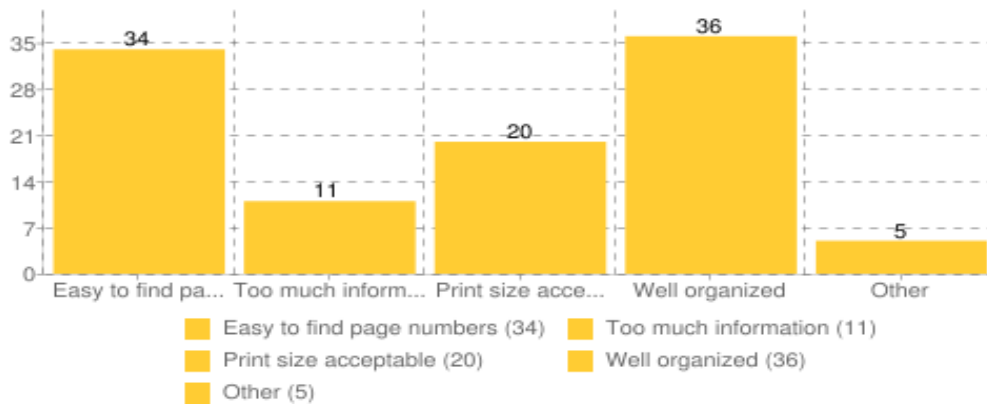
**2. Which Assembly experiences will help you and your congregation fulfill God's mission in the world?**



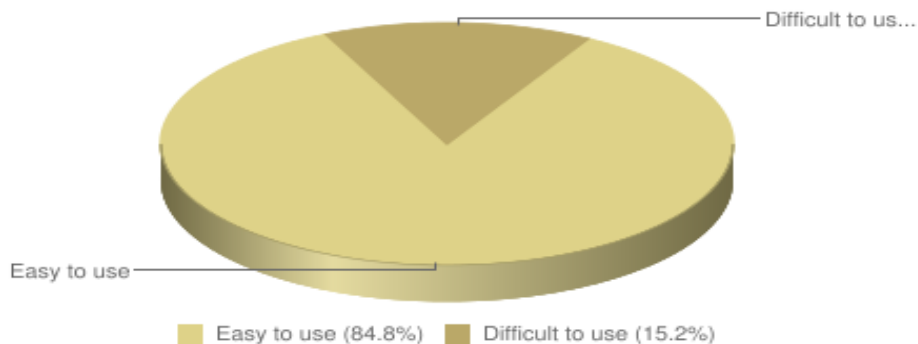
**3. How helpful were the panel presentations in answering questions about reports and recommendations?**



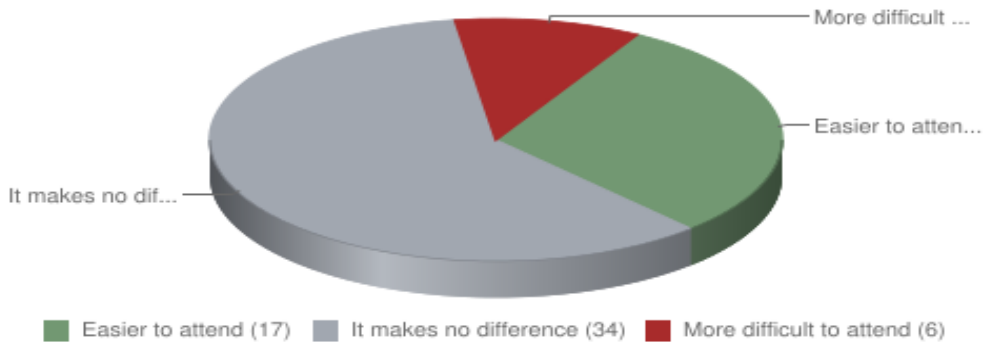
**4. The Book of Reports, comments:**



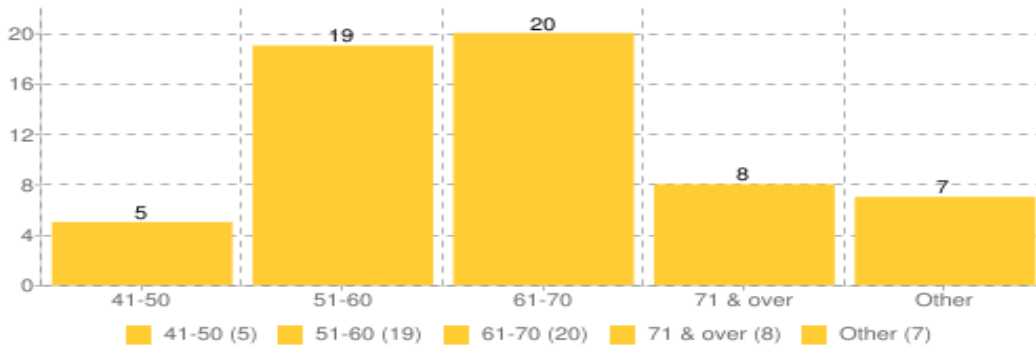
**5. The PDF version of the Book of Reports, percentage:**



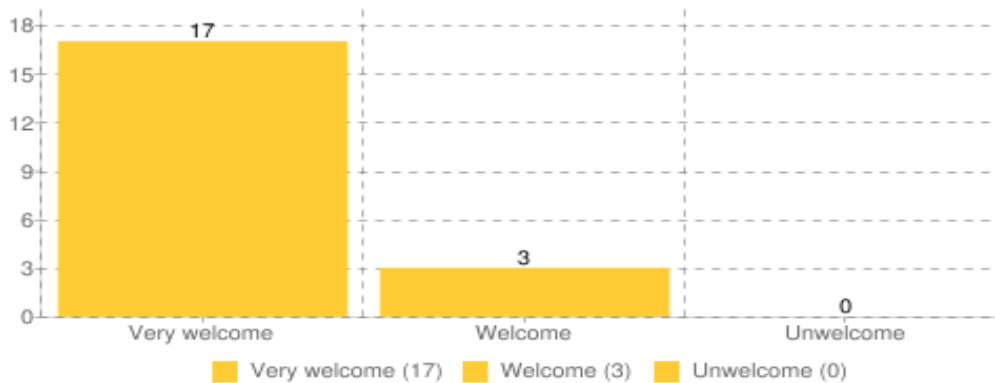
## 6. Holding General Assembly on a Weekend



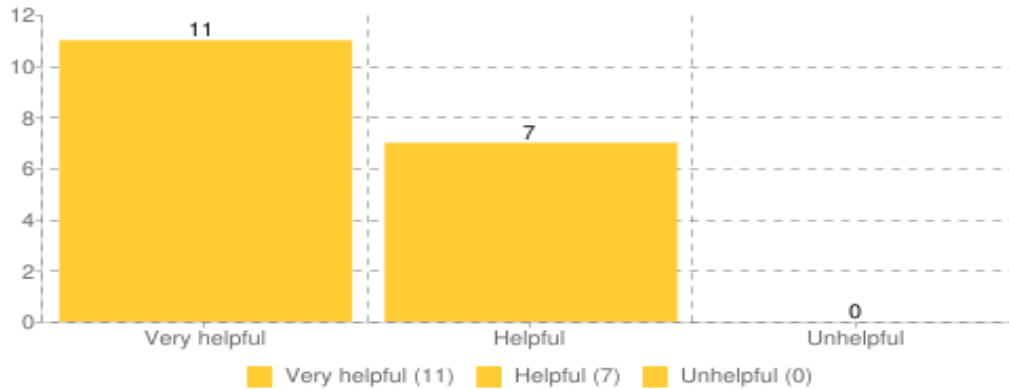
## Age Range (to measure if the weekend Assembly is affecting this demographic)

### OVERALL REPRESENTATIVE COMMENTS
