This list of suggested songs from the *Book of Praise* (1997) is based on readings for the Sundays and festivals of the liturgical year, as appointed in the *Revised Common Lectionary* (1992, The Consultation on Common Texts.)

We trust that these resources will continue to support and encourage the use of the *Book of Praise*, to the glory of God and to the building of Christ's church.

Notes

- 1. Please consult each year's published Lectionary tables for the Scripture readings proper to each day.
- 2. The selected songs are arranged in a sequence based on the fourfold pattern of worship, i.e., each song in a group is given in order, corresponding to Gathering, the Word (often a metrical psalm), the Response, and Sending Forth. (One song is provided for each of these four segments of the worship service.)
- 3. Some Sundays and special days are common to all three Lectionary years (A, B & C.) Song suggestions for these days are given in **Table IV**, after the table for Year C.
