



Getting to and from Toronto and Hamilton Airports to Brock University will take some time, you have several choices of how to do so...

Hamilton Airport

From the Airport, you can use taxis, rideshare (such as Uber), or public transportation.

UberXL provides transport for up to 6 people for approx. \$210.

Mega Bus (megabus.com) offers daily service from Hamilton Airport at 2:30pm to the St. Catharines Bus Terminal (1 hour trip). Public transit can then take you to Brock University (various buses/schedules). Mega Bus tickets can be booked in advance online.

Public Transit: Google Maps can help you find public transit options for your travel time. This will generally involve taking Hamilton Transit (HSR) to a GO transit stop near the QEW highway, then a GO bus to Fairview Mall in St. Catharines, and then either a Niagara Region Transit bus or rideshare to Brock.

Pearson Airport, Toronto

From the Airport, you can use taxis, rideshare (such as Uber), or public transportation.

UberXL provides transport for up to 6 people for approx. \$320.

Mega Bus & GO Transit: The UP Train that travels from Pearson Airport to Union Station in downtown Toronto (\$12.35; 45 minutes). From Union Station, you can take GO Transit or the Mega Bus to St. Catharines.

Mega Bus (megabus.com) runs hourly (approx.) from Union Station to the St. Catharines Bus Terminal (approx. 1 hour 20 minutes). Take a Niagara Region Transit bus or rideshare to Brock.

GO: The GO Train will take you to Burlington GO Station (approx. 1 hour, 10 min). Transfer to the GO Bus to Fairview Mall, St. Catharines (approx. 1 hour). Take a Niagara Region Transit bus or rideshare to Brock.

Public Transit: Google Maps can help you find public transit options for your travel time. This will generally involve taking a GO bus from Pearson to Burlington, transferring to a second GO bus and arriving at Fairview Mall in St. Catharines. Then you could take a Niagara Region Transit bus or rideshare to Brock.
